FOUNDATION 9 STARTING 2007 WITH MORE THAN 30 PROJECTS IN DEVELOPMENT

*Investments, mergers and acquisitions in 2006 have made
the company the largest independent developer in the world.*

NEWPORT BEACH, CA – January 31, 2007 – Foundation 9 Entertainment, the largest independent developer in the world, today announced that its studios are working on more than 30 projects on all platforms for more than 10 publishing partners. The projects currently in development are slated for release throughout 2007 and 2008.

“2006 was a very busy year for us,” says Jon Goldman, chairman and CEO. “The additions of Amaze and Shiny to our group, as well as our investment from Francisco Partners, have put us in a great position to deliver top-notch titles for years to come.”

Foundation 9 Entertainment became the largest independent videogame developer in the world in late 2006, with Shiny Entertainment from Atari and Amaze Entertainment joining the company. The company now has 10 studios across the United States and Canada and employs nearly 750 people.

Announced projects slated for release in the first half of calendar year 2007 include, *Brooktown: Senior Year* for Sony PSP® (PlayStation®Portable) Handheld Entertainment System, *Death, Jr. & the Science Fair of Doom* for Nintendo DS™ and *Castlevania: Symphony of the Night* for Xbox Live® Arcade, all published by Konami; *Call of Duty®: Roads to Victory* for PSP, published by Activision; and *Prince of Persia®: Rival Swords* for PSP, published by Ubisoft.

Other projects in development include the recently announced *Godzilla®: Unleashed*, to be published by Atari, Inc., *Dirty Harry*, to be published by Warner Bros. Interactive Entertainment, all-new original title *Harker*, all-new comic book property, *Pherone*, and many other as yet unannounced projects.

By the end of 2006, Foundation 9’s studios had released 37 titles on nearly all platforms, including the award-winning *Marc Ecko’s Getting Up: Contents Under Pressure*, published by Atari, Inc.; *Age of Empires: The Age of Kings*, published by Majesco; and *Ultimate Mortal Kombat 3*, published by Midway. Other titles included *Death, Jr. 2: Root of Evil*, published by Konami; *Sonic Rivals*, published by SEGA; *Eragon*, published by Vivendi Games; *Rampage: Total Destruction*, published by Midway and the *SEGA Genesis Collection*, published by SEGA.
